The future project would have further strengthened cooperation on water quality management in Central Asian states through piloting joint monitoring of water quality and application of joint analysis, data and information sharing. However, no donors have shown interest to support this proposal, hence the recommendation is closed as of December 2019.

3	For similar projects of the UNECE, the furniture and equipment class of expenditure ("Investments" budget component) can be regarded as not appropriate. It is recommended to the UNECE to ensure that the project starts without delay or, should it be impossible, that the Project term is extended proportionally.	UNECE accepts this recommendation. Better situation analysis will be conducted at the project design stage to ensure the project starts without delay. The recommendation on furniture and equipment is also accepted.	Environment Division Batyr Hajiyev, Economic Affairs Officer	Implemented in June 2019. These recommendations were considered and included in the project proposal. The situation analysis was conducted in close cooperation with agencies concerned and furniture/investment component is excluded from the project proposal.
4	The UNECE is recommended to explore the possibility of the Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation (SDC) support for meetings of the RWG in the future via its Blue Peace initiative. The UNECE could also approach other donors to request funding for more specific activities, including joint monitoring of water.	UNECE accepts this recommendation. The SDC supported the meeting of the RWG in February 2019. Funding opportunities will be explored in 2019. 5	The UNECE should continue working with the Governments of the five Central Asia countries on the problem of quality of water. Provided the donor funding is secured, the UNECE could design similar projects not to lose the momentum and to have a long-lasting impact.	UNECE accepts this recommendation. Draft project document is developed, and funding is sought. The draft project among others include: improvement of transboundary monitoring systems and establishing a mechanism for data and information exchange. The project proposal was declined, hence the recommendation is closed as of December 2019.
6	If the UNECE secures funding and decides to continue supporting the RWG and the "quality of water" theme in Central Asia in general, it could consider doing this in close cooperation with other development partners.	UNECE accepts this recommendation. Discussions are ongoing with the SDC, EU (under the NPD process) and other UN organizations active in Central Asia to establish cooperation on water quality issues in Central Asia.	Environment Division Batyr Hajiyev, Economic Affairs Officer	Closed and not implemented In 2019, UNECE sought to include the water quality component under the NPD process for Central Asia through a new project. However, as UNECE was not successful in mobilizing resources, this proposition will not materialize, hence the recommendation is closed as of December 2019.
