Who is who...

- Main beneficiaries are the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources and the State Agency on Alternative and Renewable Energy Resources
- SEA will be carried out by the team of the national and international experts
- Coordinated by the Regional Environmental Centre Caucasus, Branch Office in Azerbaijan
- UNECE representatives will supervise the whole process













Inputs and cooperation needed

- Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources
 - Following the SEA process in order to meet all legal and administrative obligations
 - Use SEA pilot for 'testing' the SEA procedure as stipulated by the draft EIA/SEA Law
 - Providing data and information regarding relevant environmental aspects
 - Attending regular meetings with the SEA team
- State Agency on Alternative and Renewable Energy Resources
 - Providing feedback on SEA findings and recommendations
 - Attending regular meetings with the SEA team













Inputs and cooperation needed

SEA national experts

- Inputs to the scoping report (following conclusions from the scoping workshop)
- Inputs to the SEA report (considering comments received during scoping consultations)
- Facilitation of discussions at the meetings and consultations

SEA international experts

- Methodological back-up and coordination
- Supporting national experts at the key meetings
- Quality review of interim outputs













Inputs and cooperation needed

- REC Caucasus, Branch Office in Azerbaijan
 - Management of SEA process
 - Arranging practical aspects (rooms, interpreting etc.)

- UNECE representatives
 - Quality control of the entire SEA process
 - Attending the key meetings in Azerbaijan













Stages of SEA Pilot

- 1. Scoping and baseline analysis: March May 2015
- 2. Impacts analysis and formulation of mitigation measures:

 May July 2015

- 3. Drafting SEA Report: July August 2015

4. Consultations on draft SEA Report: September 2015
