Re: Communication to the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee concerning compliance by the Czech Republic with provision of the Convention in connection with non-discrimination and public participation in the decision-making for the Temelin nuclear power project (ACCC/C/2012/71)

At its virtual meeting on 13 September 2016, the Aarhus Convention Compliance Committee finalized its findings with regard to the above communication in closed session, taking into account the comments from the communicant of 11 July 2016 and the Party concerned of 6 September 2016.
