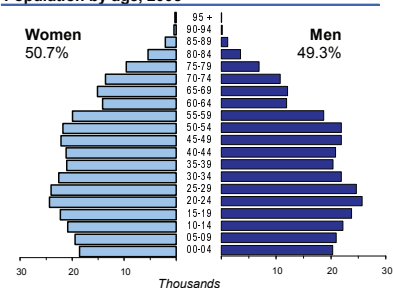

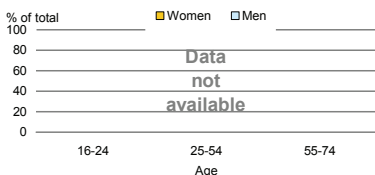

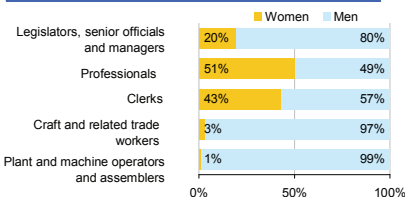

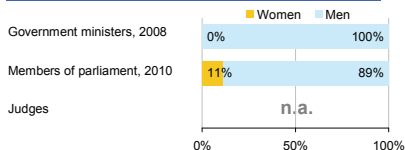

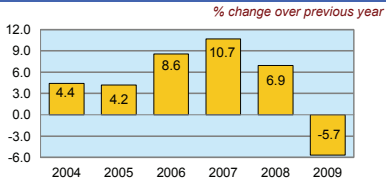

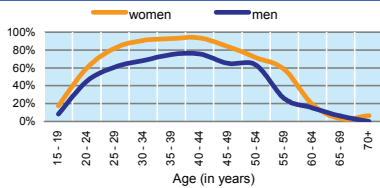

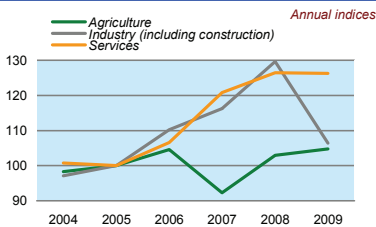
Real GDP growth rate

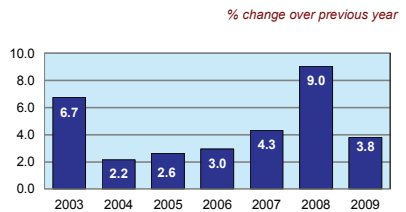

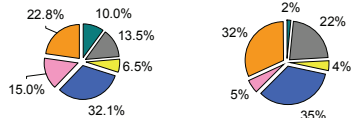

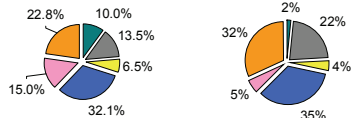
Consumer price index
