CIRCULAR LETTER N° 18 - Geneva, 1 October 2012

The "Association of the International Road Transport Operators of the Kyrgyz Republic" (AIRTO-KR/092), has been designated as the issuing and guaranteeing Association for TIR Carnets in the Kyrgyz Republic as of 1 October 2012

Addressees: TIR Carnet issuing and guaranteeing associations

We have the pleasure to inform you that the "Association of the International Road Transport Operators of the Kyrgyz Republic" (AIRTO-KR/092) has been designated by the competent authorities of the Kyrgyz Republic as the new issuing and guaranteeing Association for TIR Carnets on its territory in conformity with article 6 and Annex 9, part I of the TIR Convention, 1975.

Further to this designation, AIRTO-KR was subjected to a thorough TIR admission procedure, which was accomplished with success under the supervision of the IRU Audit Commission.

Consequently, the International Insurers have agreed to guarantee not only those TIR Carnets issued by AIRTO-KR but also TIR Carnets issued by other TIR issuing associations affiliated to the IRU and used on the territory of the Kyrgyz Republic.

AIRTO-KR, therefore started its issuing and guaranteeing activities on 1 October 2012 at 00:00 GMT, ensuring continuity from the activities of the former Kyrgyz TIR association, Kyrgyz AIA.

In this connection, please note that TIR Carnets previously issued by Kyrgyz AIA will remain fully valid and therefore should be taken into charge if presented to the competent Customs authorities of TIR Contracting Parties within the expiry date indicated in item 1 on the TIR Carnet cover page.

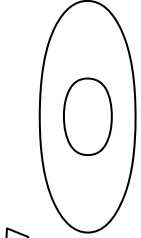
