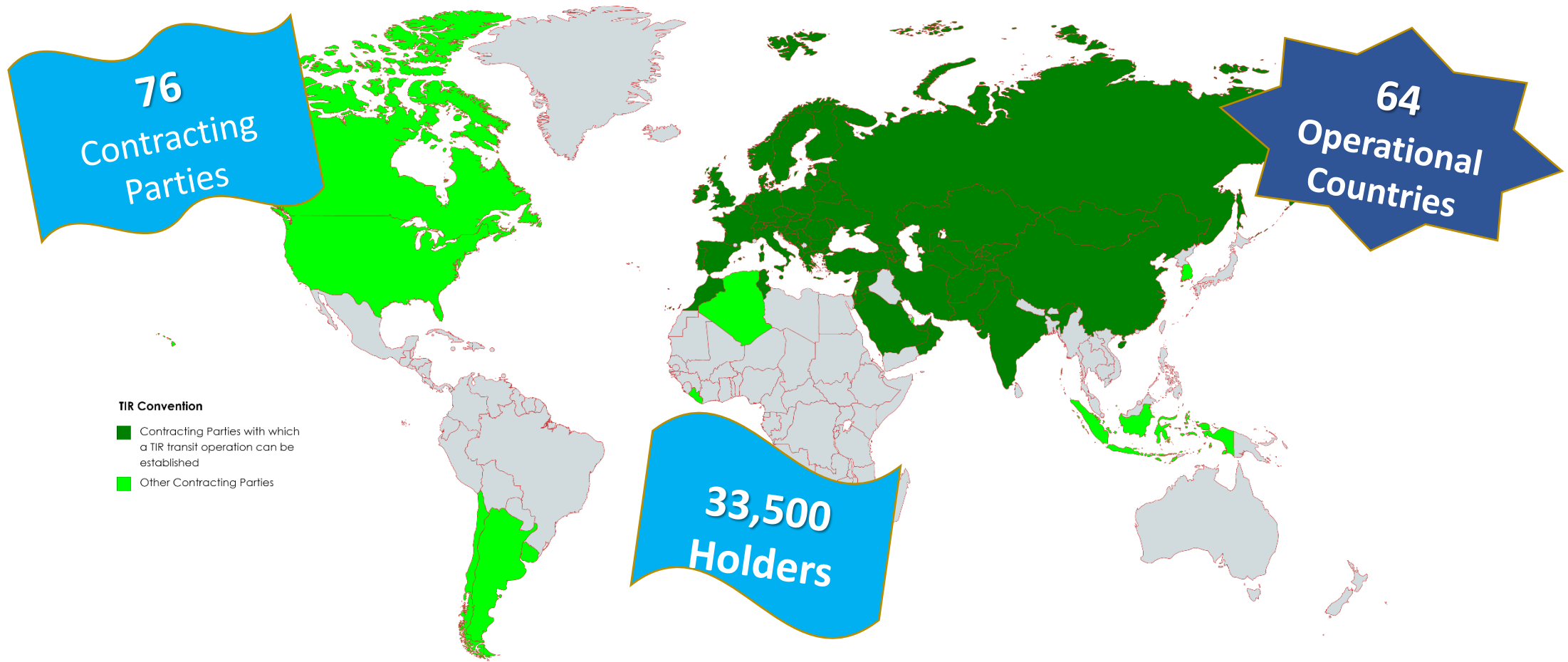

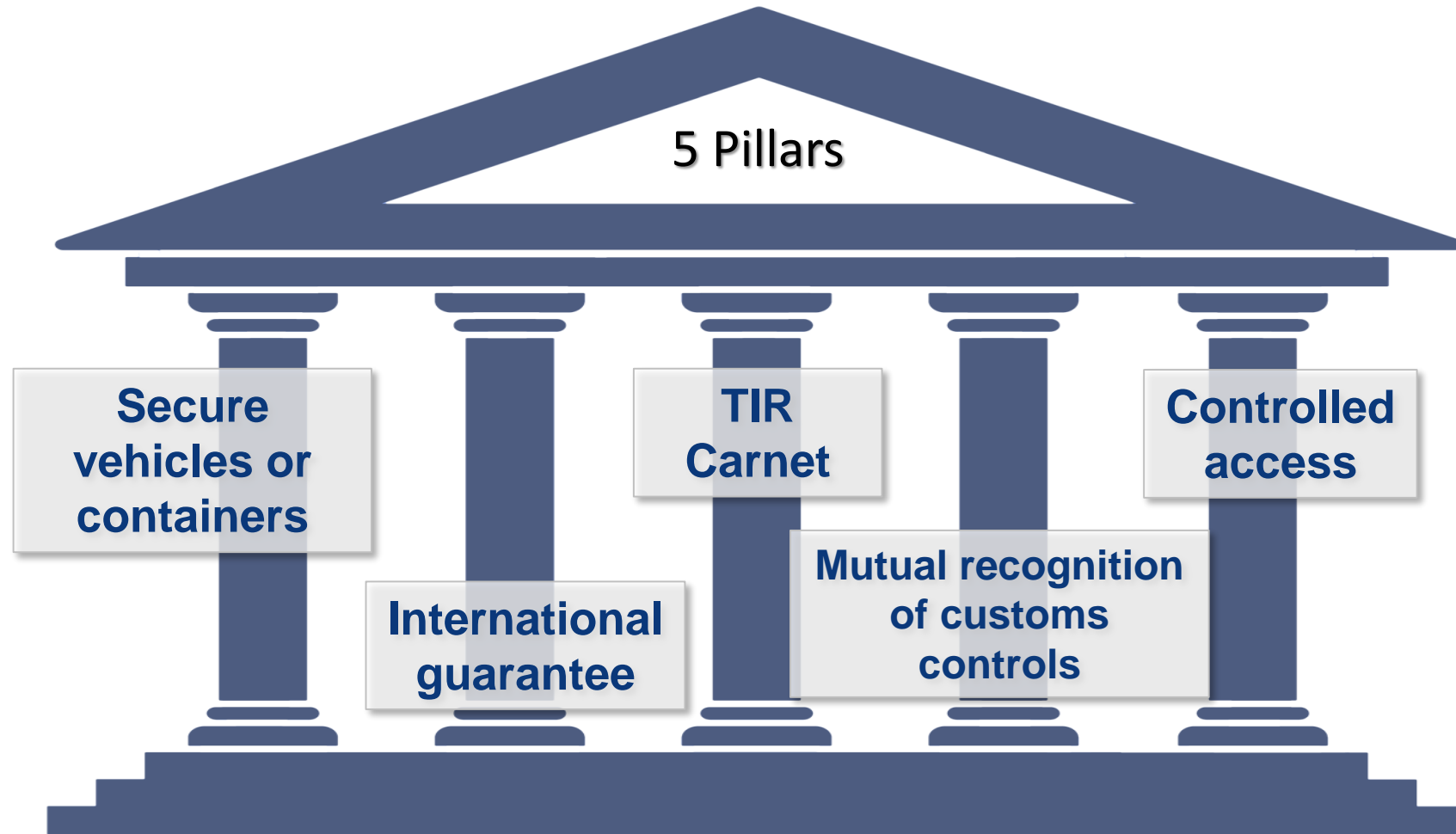

Customs Convention on the International Transport of Goods under cover of TIR Carnets (TIR Convention, 1975)

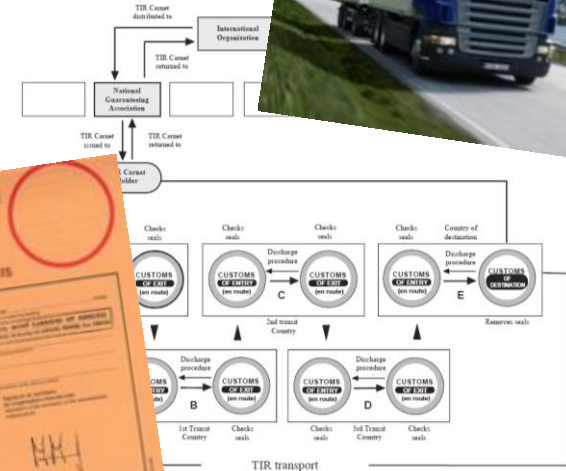
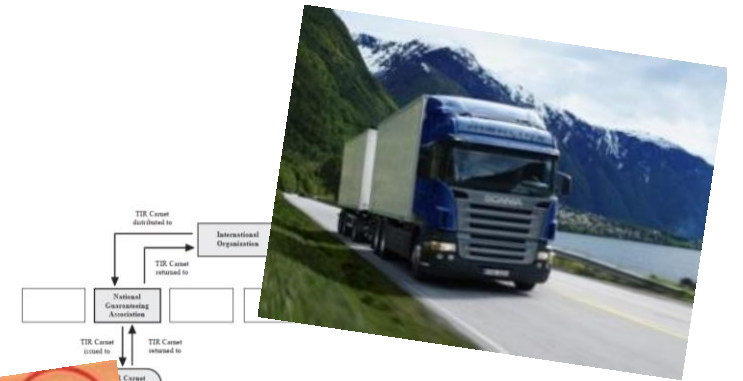


Principles



Merits of TIR System

- Harmonized procedures
- Standardized and reliable documentation
- Approved operators and vehicles
- Exceptional physical inspection
- International guarantee
- A supervisory body (TIRExB)

- Computerization of the TIR System

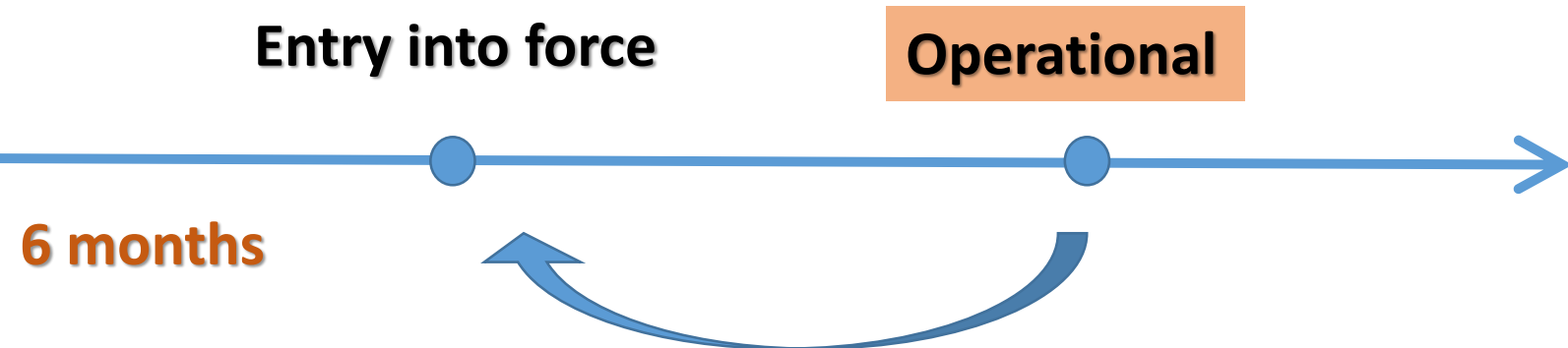

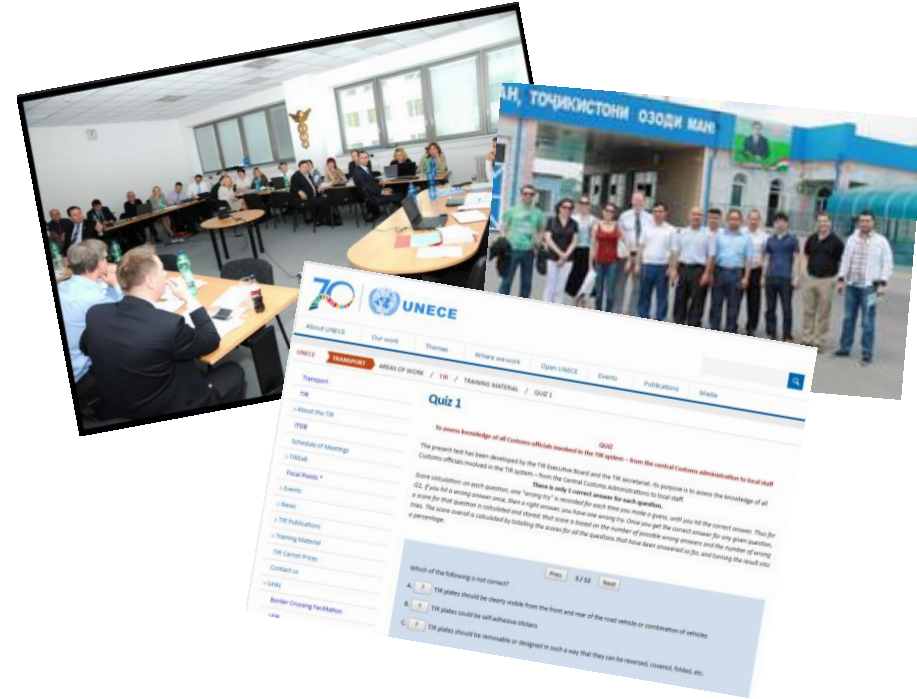
