PEACHES AND NECTARINES

Transmitted by the European Community

Note by the secretariat: The European Community has transmitted the following proposals for amending the UNECE Standard for Peaches and Nectarines (FFV-26). Additions have been marked in bold and deletions have been crossed out.

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II. PROVISIONS CONCERNING QUALITY

The purpose of the standard is to define the quality requirements for peaches and nectarines at the export control stage, after preparation and packaging.

A. Minimum requirements

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They must be sufficiently developed and display satisfactory ripeness.

The development and state of maturity $^{(2)}$ of the peaches and nectarines must be such as to enable them:

- to continue their ripening process and to reach a satisfactory degree of ripeness,
- to withstand transport and handling,
- to arrive in satisfactory condition at the place of destination.

⁽²⁾ The refractometrix index of the peaches and nectarines flesh must be greater than or equal to 8° Brix and the firmness must be lower than 6,5 kg / 0,5 cm².
