3. Proposals to revise UNECE Standards

(a) Early and Ware Potatoes

A Working Group on Early and Ware Potatoes was set up by the Specialized Section at its 2006 session and is composed of representatives from Belgium, France (rapporteur), Germany, Netherlands, the United States and Europatat. They will present the results of their discussions on the application and further development of the standard on potatoes adopted by the Working Party in 2006.

(e) Apples

The Working Group of representatives from Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, New Zealand, South Africa, the United States, the European Community (rapporteur) and COPA/COGECA (Committee of Professional Agricultural Organisations / General Confederation of Agricultural Co-operatives in the European Union) will report on the results of its work to develop a practical and easy-to-understand approach to uniformity. The Working Group was asked by the Specialized Section to take into consideration the fixed-sized charts from COPA/COGECA and the output of the September 2006 meeting of the Codex Alimentarius Committee on Fresh Fruit and Vegetables.

5. Amendments to the general texts

(b) Standard Layout

The delegations will revisit this issue on the basis of the German proposal (TRADE/WP.7/GE.1/2005/16) concerning the application of standards at different stages of marketing. The Specialized Section will also try to clarify how tolerances for different parameters should be applied, including with regard to maturity.

Some of the proposals concerning the Cucumber Standard have more general implications. Therefore, the proposals related to "practically free from damage caused by pests" and to "(slight) skin defects" in Classes I and II, as mentioned in INF.12, will be discussed under this agenda item.
