

2. Matters of interest since the last session

(a) UNECE and subsidiary bodies

The secretariat will present the developments regarding the Committee on Trade and the Working Party on Agricultural Quality Standards having an impact on the work of the Specialized Section.

4. Review of UNECE Recommendations

The Specialized Section will review the following Recommendations, which were adopted by the 2009 session of the Working Party for trial use until November 2010.

(a) Inshell Macadamia Nuts

At its 2009 session the Working Party adopted the revised text of the Recommendation for Inshell Macadamia Nuts for trial use until the end of 2010. The Specialized Section may consider amendments to the text if necessary.

(b) Macadamia Kernels

At its 2009 session the Working Party adopted the revised text of the Recommendation for Macadamia Kernels for trial use until the end of 2010. The Specialized Section may consider amendments to the text if necessary.

(c) Pistachio Kernels and Peeled Pistachio Kernels

At its 2009 session, the Working Party returned the text of the proposed new Standard to the Specialized Section to revisit several technical aspects including the differing interpretations of the term "Gülic" and the withdrawal of the provision "insufficiently developed" in section IV (Peeled Pistachio Kernels). The Working Party extended the trial period until November 2010.

(d) Hazelnut Kernels

At its 2009 session, the Working Party returned the text of the revised recommendation for hazelnut kernels to the Specialized Section to reconsider provisions on minimum requirements as requested by the delegation of Turkey. The Working Party extended the trial period until November 2010.
