Delegations will consider the texts of the recommendations for eggs and egg products and will decide whether the texts should be submitted to the Working Party for approval as new UNECE standards.

#### 6. **Proposals for new UNECE standards**

Delegations will review the draft texts of the following standards and will decide on their submission to the Working Party for adoption as recommendations for trial use until the end of 2010.

#### (a) Horse meat – carcases and cuts

*Documentation*: Draft new UNECE standard for horse meat – carcases and cuts (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2010/3)

The delegation of the Russian Federation will present a draft text of the new standard for horse meat – carcases and cuts.

#### (b) Goose meat – carcases and parts

*Documentation*: Draft new UNECE standard for goose meat – carcases and parts (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2010/4)

The delegation of China will present a draft text of the new standard for goose meat – carcases and parts.

## (c) Veal meat – carcases and cuts

*Documentation:* Draft new UNECE standard for veal meat – carcases and cuts (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2010/5)

Delegations will consider a revised proposal for a new standard for veal meat – carcases and cuts, which was discussed at the 2009 session of the Section.

## (d) Retail meat cuts

*Documentation:* Draft new UNECE standard for retail meat cuts (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2010/6)

The delegation of the United States of America will present a draft text of a new UNECE standard for retail meat cuts, first part – beef cuts

## 7. Coding system for UNECE standards for meat

*Documentation:* Coding system for UNECE standards for meat (ECE/TRADE/C/WP.7/GE.11/2010/7)

Participants will discuss how to use the UNECE standards for meat to support product classification in the United Nations Standard Products and Services Code® (UNSPSC®), the GS1 Global Data Synchronization Network (GDSN), and the Global Product Classification (GPC) system.
