

# 4. Proposal for new UNECE Standards

The Specialized Section will review the following the draft texts of the following standards and will decide on their submission to the Working Party for adoption.

#### (a) Horse meat – carcases and cuts

The delegation of the Russian Federation will present the revised draft text of the new standard for horse meat - carcases and cuts. The Specialized Section will consider final amendments to the text if necessary.

#### (b) Goose meat – carcases and parts

The delegation of China will present the revised draft text of the new standard for goose meat – carcases and parts. The Specialized Section will consider final amendments to the text if necessary.

#### (c) Veal meat – carcases and cuts

Delegations will consider the revised proposal for a new standard for veal meat – carcases and cuts. The Specialized Section will consider final amendments to the text if necessary.

#### (d) Retail meat cuts

# 5. Finalization of the UNECE Standard for Edible meat co-products

The Section was informed that several images were still missing in the Standard for Edible Meat Co-Products (adopted by the Working Party in 2008). At the 2010 session of the Section, the delegation of France had offered to finalize the document. Countries had been asked to review the document and send images to the secretariat. The Specialized Section is asked to consider the images and approve their inclusion into the final Standard.

### 6. Revision of existing UNECE Standards

At the 2010 session of the Specialized Section, delegates agreed that a revision phase was needed to update most of the Standards for meat to make them more relevant, comprehensible and user friendly for operators. Delegations were also asked to report at the next session on implementation and use of the standards. The Section is requested to decide which standards should be revised (Bovine meat, Caprine meat, Chicken meat, Duck meat, Edible meat co-products, Llama/alpaca meat, Ovine meat, Porcine meat, Turkey meat); if they could be grouped (e.g. bovine and ovine meat; chicken and turkey meat, etc.); who would act as Rapporteur(s); and where working group meetings would take place. The Specialized Section is requested to prepare a schedule listing responsible delegations; (Rapporteur(s)); venues and dates.

#### 7. Other business

Any other issues of interest for the work of the Specialized Section can be discussed under this agenda item.

#### 8. Future work

The Specialized Section will discuss proposals and priorities for its future work.

# 9. Election of officers

The Specialized Section will elect a Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson. At its nineteenth session, the group elected Mr. Ian King (Australia) as its Chairperson and Mr. Craig Morris (United States) as its Vice-Chairperson.
