A first meeting of rapporteurs on revision of the porcine standard was held in St. Petersburg from 22-24 September 2003 following the invitation of the St. Petersburg branch of the Russian Customs Authority. The outcome of the discussions is contained in the documents expected from the United States. The Specialized Section will also discuss the outcome of a second meeting of rapporteurs, which will take place from 14-16 April 2004 in Warsaw, Poland. Time for drafting groups has been set aside in the timetable.
