## I. BACKGROUND

1. Explosions are likely to occur in environments such as chemical and oil industry facilities, gas stations, facilities for handling and storage of grains, woodworking areas and sugar refineries, among others. Equipment used in these environment needs to be carefully controlled
2. While it is understandable that authorities should be vigilant in such a sensitive sector, this should not become an obstacle to free trade. However, much as producers and users of this equipment act more and more globally with a single engineering approach, national laws and regulations are still markedly different in each country.
3. The Panel Session is organized to:
(a) Discuss the terms of reference of the UNECE Initiative;
(b) Analyse answers to a questionnaire that was sent out to collect evidence on regulatory practice in the main markets
(c) Highlight commonalities in the regulations that exist on the different markets so as to start work on a possible agreement.
