

(Illumination of rear registration plates)

A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 1.3., amend to read:

- "1.3. "Rear registration plate lamps of different types" means lamps which differ in such essential respects as:
 - (a) the trade name or mark;
 - (b) the characteristics of the optical system, (levels of intensity, light distribution angles, category of filament lamp, light source module, etc.);
 - the angle of incidence of the light on the surface of the plate."

B. JUSTIFICATION

The strikethrough text of paragraph 1.3. contradicts with the provisions of paragraphs 2. and 7. indicating that:

" the manufacturer of the illuminating device shall specify one or more or a field of positions in which the device is to be fitted in relation to the space for the registration plate "
