A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 1., amend to read:

"1. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to daytime running lamps for vehicles of category ${\bf L}$, ${\bf M}$, ${\bf N}$ and T $\underline{1}/."$

B. JUSTIFICATION

This document complements the proposal tabled by the expert from Germany (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2008/58) for amendments to Regulation No. 53, proposing to allow the installation of daytime running lamps, approved according to Regulation No. 87, on L_3 category vehicles.
