Activities of the TIRExB

On-line UNECE Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps

Note by the TIR secretariat

1. The TIR secretariat is mandated to maintain and update a register containing information on Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps. In 2007 the TIR secretariat launched the on-line UNECE Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps project with the aim of making available on-line the information which exists in the paper-based register.
2. The register, at present encompasses the Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps of 55 Contracting Parties in English, French and Russian for use by TIR Customs focal points and Customs officers in the field. The purpose of the electronic register is to increase efficiency, save time and minimize potential errors versus the current paper-based system.
3. At the end of 2008, the TIR secretariat finished the above mentioned project and has mandated an independent company to audit the on-line register and to certify that all the necessary security measures had been correctly implemented. The result of the audit has been extremely positive and therefore the TIR secretariat has the pleasure to inform the Contracting Parties that the on-line UNECE Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps has now been deployed and is available on line for consultation at the following web address: <http://unece.unog.ch/register>.
4. The Annex of the present document contains the User guide the on-line UNECE Register of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps.

How the Site is Organized

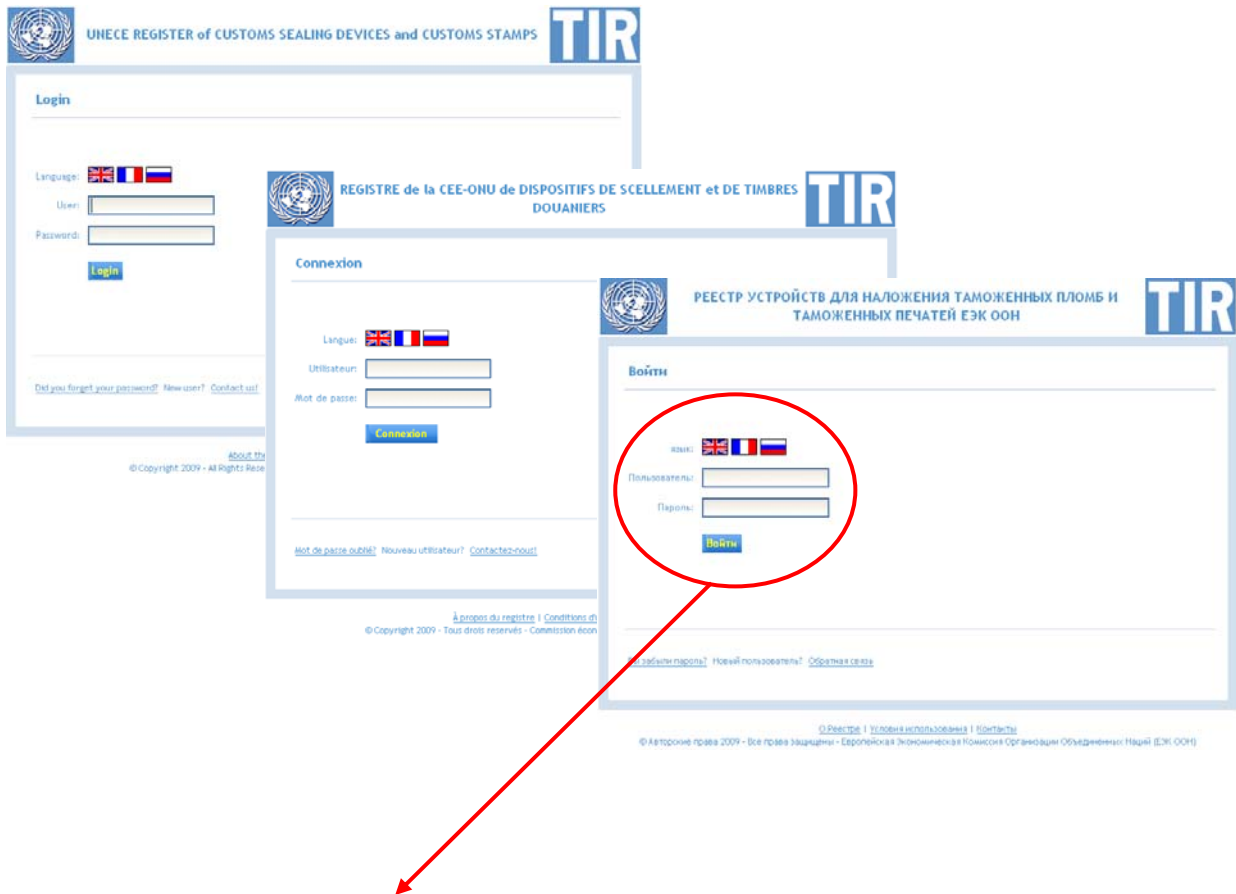
- The Home Page - <http://unece.unog.ch/register>

The multilingual website (English, French and Russian) is, for the most part, split into four parts:




- The **countries page** section, which can be accessed from the **login page**, displays all the flags of the Contracting Parties in the TIR convention.
- The **show page** displaying the information about a country, which can be accessed from the countries page, offers the information about a country's Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps.
- The **print page** provides the utility to print the information of Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps from a country.
- The **footer page** provides additional information including:
 - About the register
 - The terms of use
 - and TIR secretariat's contact information

Login Page

Use this page as your starting point where you may choose your language (English, French or Russian) and log in with your credentials in order to access the protected information from <http://unece.unog.ch/register>

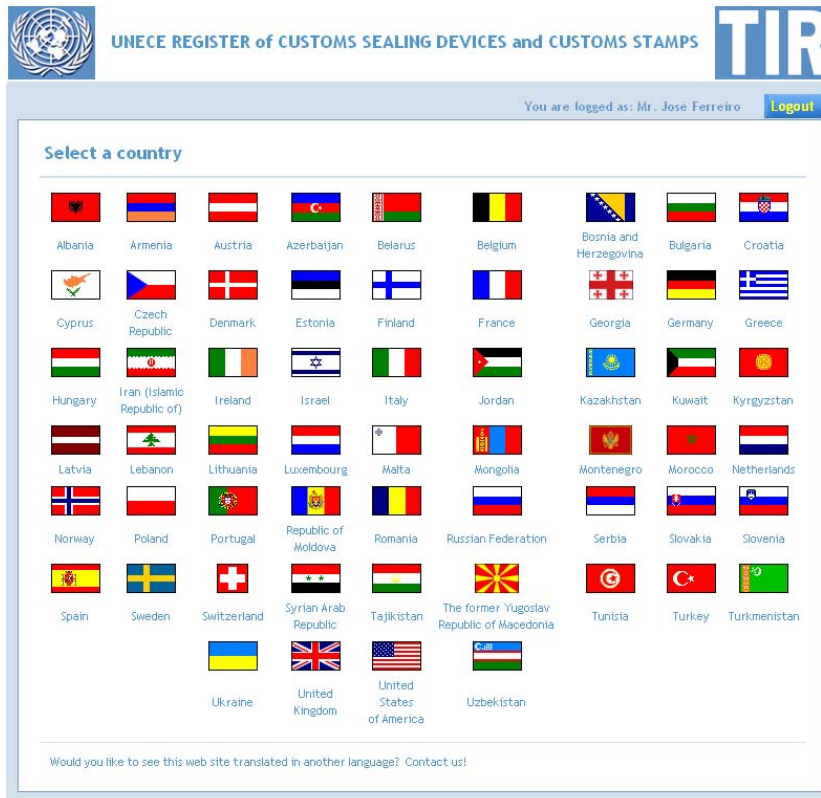

Countries Page

You will see the **countries page** once you successfully logged into the website. From this page you have access to the information provided by Contracting Parties about Customs Sealing Devices and Customs Stamps. Search for the country you are interested and select it by clicking on the flag or the name of the country.

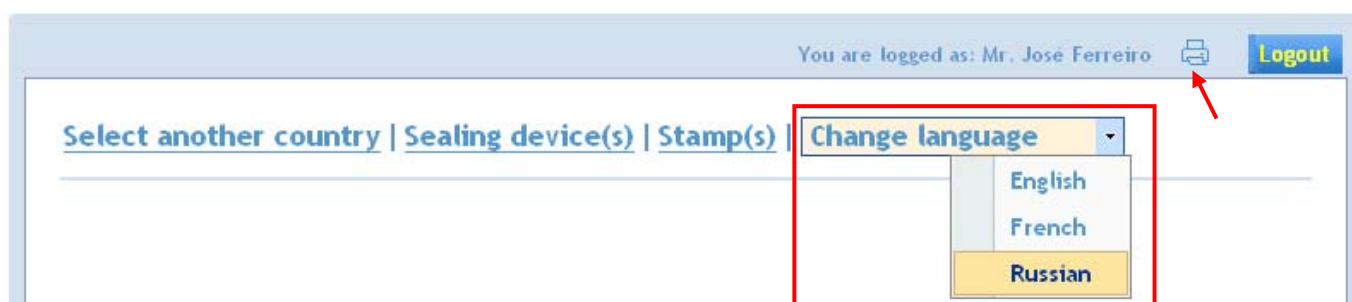


Countries page with country flags and names

Show Page

This page allows you to see the country's information that you selected in the **countries page**. The header of the **show page** allows you to navigate within the displayed page. It allows you to:

- *Select another country*: return back to the **countries page** and consult the information from another country.
- *Sealing device(s)*: It scrolls to the sealing device(s) section in the page.
- *Stamp(s)*: It scrolls to the stamp(s) section in the page.
- *Change language*: It allows you to see the displayed page in another language (English, French or Russian).
- *Print*: It allows you to print the current displayed page.
- *Logout*: It disconnects you from the website.



Show page's navigation bar

If you clicked in a country flag or name, *e.g. Azerbaijan*, then the related information will be shown. The first section of the page contains the information related to the *sealing devices* and the second section to the *stamps*.

Customs Sealing Devices

Model 1, front side:

- It consists of a head or plastic. Wires of various length and diameters are used.
- The diameter of the seals is 10 mm. After the use of the sealing device, the following is embossed on the seal "AZER", and a three-digit number of the sealing device.

Model 2, reverse side:

- Within the circle an eight-pointed star is reflected with a half-circle and with a smaller eight-pointed star inside it.

Customs Stamps

Stamp 1:

- Stamp with a personal number.
- Two circles spaced at a distance of 1 (one) mm.

You can quickly navigate to the Customs Sealing Devices section by clicking on "sealing

device(s)” provided link in the navigation bar. The page will then scroll to the area where the information is contained.

Model 1. front side:

Model 1. reverse side:


- Within the circle an eight-pointed star is reflected with a half-moon and with a smaller eight-pointed star inside it.

Show page containing Azerbaijan's Customs Sealing Devices information

The same functionality is available to scroll to the area where the information of Customs Stamps. Click on “Top” link to reach the top of the current displayed page.

By clicking on the print icon , which is located in the navigation bar, you will be taken to the **print page**, which allows you to print the information from the country that you are viewing.

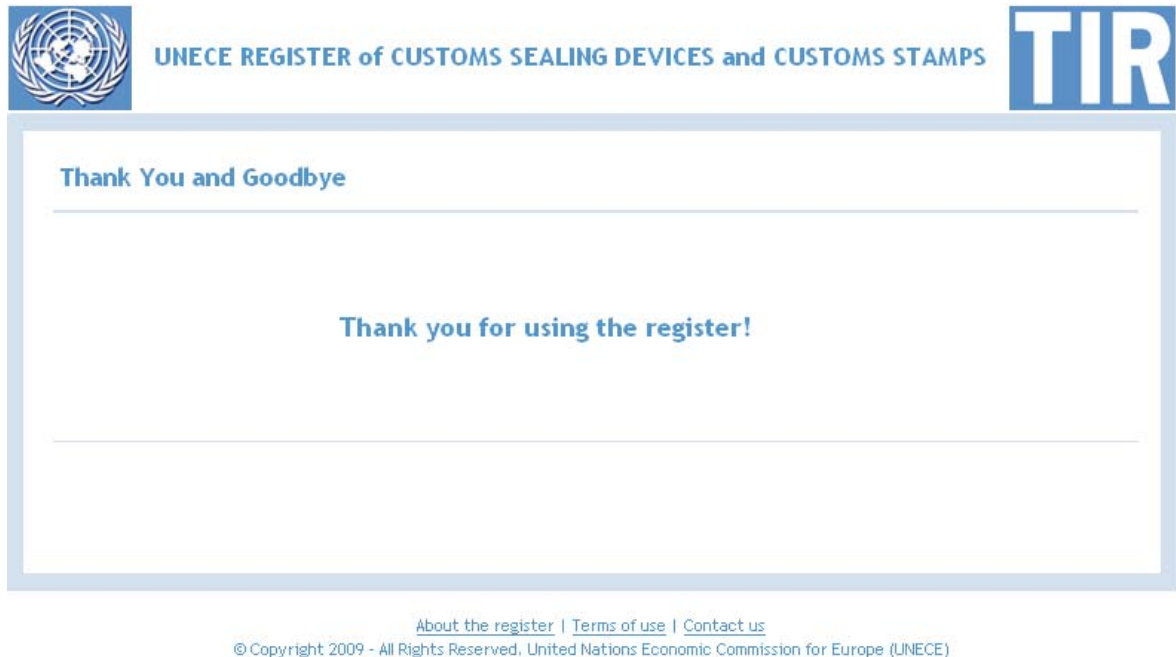
