INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE HARMONIZATION OF FRONTIER

GENEVA, 21 OCTOBER 1982

TUNISIA: ACCESSION

The Secretary-General of the United Nations, acting in his capacity as depositary,
communicates the following:

The above action was effected on 11 March 2009.

The Convention will enter into force for Tunisia on 11 June 2009 in accordance with its article
17 (2) which reads as follows:

"After five States have deposited their instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or
accession, this Convention shall enter into force for further Contracting Parties three months after the
date of the deposit of their instruments of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession."
