Note 3:	The deadline for submission of documents is <b>16 April 1999</b> . Delegations are invited to submit their proposals as soon as possible and not later than <b>16 April</b> , and to inform the secretariat at the latest by <b>9 April</b> of any document in	

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preparation that would not have yet been submitted.
