- **Note 1:** At its twenty-first session, the Committee of Experts elected Mr. S. Benassai (Italy) and Mr. F. Wybenga (United States of America) respectively Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods for the biennium 2001-2002 (ST/SG/AC.10/27, para. 161).
- Note 2: A working group on the transport of gases (item 2) will be convened in parallel on Monday 3 December in the afternoon after discussion of item 2 in plenary session. The working group will continue working in parallel as necessary and will report back to the Plenary on Friday 7 December.
- Note 3: The deadline for submission of documents is **14 September 2001**. Delegations are invited to submit their proposals as soon as possible and not later than **14 September**, and to inform the secretariat at the latest by **7 September** of any document in preparation that would not have yet been submitted.
