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A. PROPOSAL

Distinguish by marking specific components tested at $-20\,^{\circ}\text{C}$ from those tested at $-40\,^{\circ}\text{C}$.

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B. JUSTIFICATION

In annex 50 the operation temperatures of specific CNG system components are divided into two temperature categories:

moderate (not colder than -20°C), and cold (not colder than -40°C)

This is favoured by the Russian Federation. However, the Regulation does not contain any provisions concerning marking or identification of parts. It would therefore not be possible to establish the conformity of specific components to one or the other temperature category (this concerns all specific components, except containers).

A corresponding proposal should be prepared.
