OICA PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No 100 CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF BATTERY ELECTRIC VEHICLES WITH REGARD TO SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND FUNCTIONAL SAFETY

A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 5.3.1: add at the end the following text:

recom	binant" ba	tteries are	exclu	ded					

B. JUSTIFICATION

We think that batteries with non-aqueous electrolyte should be excluded, because these do not produce hydrogen emissions.

In the case that sealed "gas recombinant" batteries are used, which do not require maintenance, electrolyte refilling and do not release emissions to the atmosphere, we think that they should not be subjected to these requirements.
