- Note 1: At its twenty-first session, the Committee of Experts elected Mr. S. Benassai (Italy) and Mr. F. Wybenga (United States of America) respectively Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods for the biennium 2001-2002 (ST/SG/AC.10/27, para. 161).
- **Note 2:** A working group on the transport of gases will be convened in parallel on Monday 1 July in the morning after discussion of item 2 in plenary session. The working group will continue working in parallel as necessary and will report back to the Plenary on or before Friday 5 July.
- **Note 3:** A working group on fireworks will be convened in parallel on Monday 1 July in the morning after discussion of item 3(a) in plenary session, until Wednesday 3 July evening.
- **Note 4:** A working group on ammonium nitrate emulsions will be convened in parallel on Thursday 4 July and Friday 5 July.
- **Note 5:** The deadline for submission of documents is **5 April 2002**. Delegations are invited to submit their proposals as soon as possible and not later than **5 April**, and to inform the secretariat at the latest by **29 March** of any document in preparation that would not have yet been submitted.
- **Note 7**: For reasons of economy, delegations are invited to keep their own copies of documents and to bring them to the meeting.
