GRE INFORMAL GROUP FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ADAPTIVE FRONTLIGHTING SYSTEMS (AFS)

TERMS OF REFERENCE:

The informal group shall revise the draft amendments to a new draft Regulation – UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF ADAPTIVE FRONTLIGHTING SYSTEMS (AFS) FOR MOTOR VEHICLES-, proposed by Working Party "Brussels 1952" (GTB) (documents TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2002/18 and TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2002/20, to be revised) including the proposed amendments on which GRE agreed during its forty-ninth session. The result of work of the informal group shall be considered by GRE at its fiftieth session in April 2003.

RULES OF PROCEDURE:

- 1. The informal group is open to all participants of GRE.
- 2. A Chairman (government representative) and a Secretary shall govern the informal group.
- 3. The official language of the informal group should be English.
- 4. All documents and/or proposals must be submitted to the Secretary of the group in a suitable electronic format in advance of the meeting.
 - The group may refuse to discuss any item or proposal which has not been circulated 10 working days in advance.
- 5. An agenda and related documents will be circulated to all members of the informal group in advance of all scheduled meetings.
- 6. All communications of the informal group will be directed to the GRE heads of delegations.
- 7. The conclusions of the informal group shall be based on a majority vote of governmental members.
- 8. If the informal group could not reach a common agreement, the proposals shall be presented to GRE, in order to take a decision.
