## A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 5.1.4., amend to read:

" ....the provisions of Regulation No. 89. The device shall be set in such a way that the speed cannot exceed 90 km/h, bearing in mind the technological tolerance of the device."

Paragraph 5.1.1.5.1., amend to read (including footnote  $\underline{5}/$ ):

" ......

..... temperature class T6, shall be met.

However, for permanently energized electrical equipment installed in an environment where the temperature caused by non-electrical equipment situated in that environment exceeds the T6 temperature limit, the temperature classification of the permanently energized electrical equipment shall be at least that of the T4 temperature class.

## B JUSTIFICATION

The general aim is to align the prescriptions of Regulation No. 105 on the prescriptions of the re-structured ADR (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road) - version of 2001. This will allow the Contracting Parties to the Regulation to apply it being in accordance with the ADR.
