Proposal

In 6.5.4.7.1 Leakproofness test

Change

- "... for liquids or for solids loaded or discharged under pressure, ..." to
 "... for solids loaded* or discharged under pressure or for liquids, ...".
- Justification
- 1) This wording will avoid any misinterpretation that leakproofness testing would only apply to liquids when these are loaded or discharged under pressure.
 - 2) This rearrangement restores the order used in RID/ADR 1999 where the order is to have the IBC type 21 (for solids, filled* or discharged under pressure) before the IBC type 31 (for liquids).

*Remark

The consistent wording to be used should be "fill/discharge" when the amount of, product within a containment is changed, and "load/unload" when the closed package IBC etc. is handled.
