PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT SUPPLEMENT 6 TO REGULATION No. 91

(Side-marker lamps)

Transmitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE)

<u>Note</u>: The text reproduced below was adopted by GRE at its forty-ninth session, and is transmitted for consideration to WP.29 and AC.1. It is based on the relevant sections of documents TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2002/32 and TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2002/35, both not amended (TRANS/WP.29/GRE/49, paras. 116 and 117).

Paragraph 2.3., amend to read:

- "2.3. "<u>Side-marker lamps of different types</u>" means side-marker lamps which do not differ in such essential respects as:
 - the trade name or mark;
 - the characteristics of the optical system (level of intensity, light distribution angles, category of the filament lamp, etc.).

The colour of the filament lamp or the colour of any filter does not constitute a change of type."

Insert a new paragraph 9.3., to read:

"9.3. The limits of the apparent surface in the direction of the reference axis of a light-signalling device shall be determined."
