The fiftieth session was initially scheduled to be held from 8 to 11 April 2003. However, during its last session (TRANS/WP.29/GRE/49, paras. 129 and 131), GRE decided to start the session on Monday, 7 April 2003 with the informal meeting on AFS, without interpretation. This modification to the agenda was endorsed by WP.29 at its one-hundred-and-twenty-eighth session in November 2002 (TRANS/WP.29/885, paras. 27 and 56). Full interpretation will only be provided from Tuesday afternoon to Friday, but not on Monday and Tuesday morning.
