## Addition to document 2003/59

## Transmitted by the Government of Belgium

This informal document supplements the proposal contained in document 2003/59.

Besides the contradiction between provision PP6 and R01, LP01 and LP02 explained in document 2003/59, the analysis of the table of inf 3 from the Netherlands (Relation between classification of Dangerous Goods and conditions of carriage) shows that :

- Amongst the substances of class 6.1, classification code T1, packing group II and III, only the substances of UN 1851 are subject to PP6.
- Amongst the substances of class 6.1, classification code T2, packing group II and III, only the substances of UN 3249 are subject to PP6.
- Amongst the substances of class 3, classification code FT1, packing group II and III, only the substances of UN 3248 are subject to PP6.

This seems to indicate that the restriction of PP6 might be eliminated not only for the PG III substances, but also for the ones of PG II.
