## Note by the secretariat

During the last meeting of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe's Committee for Trade, Industry and Enterprise Development (Centre for Trade Facilitation and Electronic Business (UN/CEFACT<sup>1</sup>)), held in Geneva on 22 and 23 June, a document on "Material Safety Data Sheet Business Requirement Specification" was submitted for discussion (TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23).

The UNECE Secretariat noted that the business requirement specification<sup>2</sup> contained in that document was not in line with the GHS specifications for Material Safety Data Sheets (Chapter 1.5 and Annex 4 of the GHS).

As the GHS is intended to provide a basis for the harmonization of rules and regulations on chemicals at national, regional and worldwide level, the UNECE Secretariat submitted a document suggesting the revision of the proposed specifications to take account of the GHS (see document <a href="https://receptor.org/representations-to-take-account-of-the-GHS">TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23/Add.1</a> "Comments on TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23") together with document <a href="https://representations-to-take-account-of-take-account-of-the-GHS">TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23/Add.1</a> "which reproduced the full text of Annex 4 of the GHS.

The Plenary took note of document TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23 and requested the International Trade and Business Processes Permanent Group (TBG Group) to take into account the provisions and results of related work as laid down in the documents submitted by the UNECE Secretariat (TRADE/CEFACT/2005/23/Add.1 and TRADE/CEFACT/2005/32). The TBG was then requested to submit a revised Business Requirement Specification for review and approval of the Plenary (see <a href="Decision 05-19">Decision 05-19</a>)<sup>3</sup>.
