(Headlamps emitting an asymmetrical passing beam)

Paragraph 0., amend to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote 2/ and a new footnote 2/):

"0. SCOPE 1/

This Regulation applies to headlamps for vehicles of categories L, M, N and T 2/.
