PROPOSAL FOR DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No. 104

(Alignment of the Regulation with the 03 series of amendments to Regulation No. 48)

<u>Note</u>: The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from Germany in order to align the current provisions of Regulation No. 104 to the 03 series of amendments to Regulation No. 48 in the aspect of conspicuity markings, resulted from the discussions at the GRE informal group on "Conspicuity markings". This document is a complement to ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2006/21 and should also be considered in conjunction with the document ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2006/2. The modifications to the current text of Regulation No. 104 are marked in **bold** characters.

## A. PROPOSAL

Paragraphs 2.1.1., 2.1.2. and 2.1.3. (definitions), should be deleted.

Paragraph 2.1.4. (former), renumber as paragraph 2.1.1.

Annex 4, amend to read:

"TEST SAMPLES

1. Five test samples representing either .... in the case of planes, at least a surface of 500 mm x 500 mm shall be provided."

Annex 9, should be deleted (including Appendices 1 and 2).

## **B. JUSTIFICATION**

Reference to paragraphs. 2.1.1., 2.1.2. and 2.1.3.

These definitions had become obsolete in Regulation No. 104 since new they are covered by Regulation No. 48.03.

## Reference to Annex 4

An editorial correction. The current text says "500 x 500 mm<sup>2</sup>"

## Reference to Annex 9

Regulation No. 48.03 covers installation requirements for conspicuity markings. Consequently, the installation requirements of conspicuity markings in Regulation No. 104 is obsolete since the Regulation should cover requirements for conspicuity materials only.
