

**PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION No. 90**  
**(Clarification of the scopes of the Regulations)**

Note: The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from OICA and refers to Part 2 of document TRANS/WP.29/GRRF/2005/19 (EC). It aims to clarify the OICA position on what should be the scope of Regulation No. 90.

The modifications to the existing text of the Regulation are marked in **bold** characters.

**PART II.** (BRAKES)

**A.7. PROPOSAL**

Regulation No. 90 – Replacement brake lining assemblies

Paragraphs 1. to 1.2., amend to read:

"1. SCOPE

1.1. This Regulation applies to:

**1.1.1. Replacement service brake lining assemblies intended for use in friction brakes forming part of a braking system of vehicles of category M, N, L and O [which have a type approval in accordance with Regulation No. 13, Regulation 13-H or Regulation No. 78].**

**1.1.2. Replacement drum brake linings designed to be riveted to a brake shoe for fitment to and use on vehicles of category M<sub>3</sub>, N<sub>2</sub>, N<sub>3</sub>, O<sub>3</sub> or O<sub>4</sub> [having a type approval in accordance with Regulation No. 13]."**

**B.7. JUSTIFICATION**

The purpose of this document is the addition of vehicles of category L and of a reference to Regulation No. 13-H. OICA believes that L category was missing in document TRANS/WP.29/GRRF/2005/19 and a reference to Regulation No. 13-H is necessary because lots of vehicles are currently approved according to this Regulation.
