
Note: The text reproduced below was adopted by GRSG at its ninety-first session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2006/29, as amended by para. 42 of the report. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/70, para. 42).

Paragraph 5.2.1., amended to read:

"5.2.1. Where fitted, the controls, tell-tales and indicators, listed under the heading Column 3 of table 1, shall be identified by symbols designated for where that symbol is suitable for the application concerned."

Table 1 - Symbols, their illumination and colours, replace row 42 by rows 42a and 42b to read (including the insertion of the references to the new footnotes 16/ and 17/ and the new footnotes 16/ and 17/):

16/ Additionally, either of the low tyre pressure tell-tales may be used to indicate a tyre pressure monitoring system (TPMS) malfunction.

17/ The vehicle outline shown is not intended to be restrictive, but is the recommended outline. Alternative vehicle outlines may be used in order to better represent the actual outline of a given vehicle."
