

## REGULATION No. 48 (Installation of lighting and light-signalling devices)

### **Definitions**

Proposal for draft amendments to Regulation No. 48

Submitted by the expert from the International Organization of Motor Vehicle Manufacturers

The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the International Organization of Motor Vehicle Manufacturers (OICA) suggesting to disregard the projection of service-doorlighting systems during determination of the vehicle extreme outer edges. The modifications to the current text of the Regulation (up to Supplement 1 to the 03 series of amendments) are marked in **bold** characters.

## A. PROPOSAL

Insert a new paragraph 2.14.6., to read:

"2.14.6. of service-door lighting systems on vehicles of categories  $M_2$  and  $M_3$  as specified in paragraph 2.7."

## B. JUSTIFICATION

As with other devices mounted on the side of a vehicle, service-door lighting systems should be disregarded when determining the extreme outer edge of a vehicle.

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
