<u>Proposal for draft amendments to Regulation No. 112</u> (Headlamps emitting an asymmetrical passing beam)

Submitted by the expert from the Working Party "Brussels 1952"

The text reproduced below was prepared by the expert from the Working Party "Brussels 1952" (GTB) in order to clarify and update the provisions specifying the number of headlamps for the approval test procedure. It is based on draft Supplement 8 to Regulation No. 112, as agreed at the fifty-seventh GRE session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/57, paras. 50, 53, 55 and 62). The modifications to the text of the Regulation, including draft Supplement 8, are marked in **bold** characters.

A. PROPOSAL

Add a new paragraph 1.3.8., to read:

"1.3.8. However, a device intended for the installation on the left side of the vehicle and the corresponding device intended for the installation on the right side of the vehicle shall be considered to be of the same type."

Paragraph 2.2.3., amend to read:

"2.2.3. two samples of each type of headlamp, one sample intended for the installation on the left side of the vehicle and one sample intended for the installation of the right side of the vehicle."

B. JUSTIFICATION

The testing and approving of one headlamp intended for the installation on the left side and one headlamp intended for the installation on the right side of the vehicle has been common practice by the Technical Services of several Contracting Parties. This amendment is intended to clarify the situation and should ensure uniform procedures for all Technical Services.
