Note by the secretariat

I. INTRODUCTION

It is recalled that at its fifty-first session, the Working Party approved, in principle, a 1. number of amendments to Annexes I and II of the AGN agreements, prepared by the secretariat based on the information received in the course of the revision of the Inventory of Main Standards and Parameters of the E Waterway Network ("Blue Book". ECE/TRANS/SC.3/144/Rev.1). The Working Party, decided, however, to adopt amendments to the AGN annexes, as a package, every two years, and, therefore, postponed the formal approval of these amendments to its fifty-second session (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/178, para. 11).

2. In this context, the Working Party may wish to formally approve the amendments to annexes I and II, presented below. These amendments include the proposals, considered by the Working Party at the last session, as well as new proposals (points 6, 13, 14, 15), submitted by Governments directly concerned and reviewed by the Working Party on the Standardization of Technical and Safety Requirements in Inland Navigation (SC.3/WP.3) at its thirty-third session (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/66, para. 18).
