2. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

In accordance with the rules of procedure of the Economic Commission for Europe and established practice, the Meeting will elect a Chairman and possibly a Vice-Chairman.

3. STATUS OF THE EUROPEAN AGREEMENT CONCERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY INLAND WATERWAYS (ADN)

On 31 January 2008, Germany ratified the European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Inland Waterways (ADN), bringing the number of Contracting Parties to seven. As a consequence, the ADN entered into force one month later on 29 February 2008.

On 19 February 2008, Moldova also ratified the ADN, followed by France (approval) on 3 April 2008. The nine Contracting Parties to the ADN on 8 April 2008 are Austria, Bulgaria, France, Germany, Hungary, Luxembourg, Moldova, Netherlands and Russian Federation. Other States (Croatia, Czech Republic, Italy and Slovakia) that signed the Agreement are now expected to ratify it shortly.
