### Add a new paragraph 1.5., to read:

"1.5. It also applies to the installation of child restraint systems and ISOFIX child restraint systems designated for installation in vehicles of category  $M_1$ ,  $M_2$ ,  $M_3$  and  $N_1$ . \*/"

## Paragraph 8.3.5., amend to read:

"8.3.5. In order to inform the vehicle user(s) of the provisions made for the transport of children, vehicles of categories M<sub>1</sub>, M<sub>2</sub>, M<sub>3</sub> and N<sub>1</sub> shall meet the information requirements of Annex 17. Any vehicle of category M<sub>1</sub> shall be equipped with ISOFIX positions, in accordance with the relevant prescriptions of Regulation No. 14.
