The text reproduced below was adopted by GRE at its fifty-ninth session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2008/21, as amended by Annex II to the report (see ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/59, para.19). It is submitted to WP.29 and AC.1 for consideration.

Paragraph 5.23., amend to read:

"5.23. Lamps shall be fitted in a vehicle in such a way that the light source can be correctly replaced by the driver without the need for special tools, other than those provided with the vehicle by the manufacturer. The vehicle manufacturer shall provide with the vehicle a detailed description of the procedure for replacement. This paragraph is not applicable to: (a) Devices approved with a non-replaceable light source;

(b) Devices approved with light sources according to Regulation No. 99."
