- 1/ The sponsor will intend to seek guidance of AC.3 at the 2008 November session in case the two major pending issues (the scope and the markings) are not solved by GRRF at its September 2008 session. The informal group's intention is to present, at the GRRF session in September 2008, a first draft gtr.
- 2/ AC.3 is expected to vote the draft gtr for its establishment in the Global Registry in June 2008
- AC.3 agreed to consider the proposal for Amend. 1 to the draft gtr and its final report at its June 2008 session.

- 5/ Concerning the phase II, AC.3 agreed that once the gtr is established, a mandate will be given to the Flex-TEG group as an informal group to develop phase II of the gtr under the chairmanship of Japan. No agreement was reached so far. Official documents would be considered at the GRPE January 2009 session.

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- 1/ GRE decided to retain the agreed parts of draft gtr under a proposal for draft Regulation No. 48-H.
- AC.3 agreed to take a decision at its June 2008 session on the discontinuation of this agenda item.
- 3/ AC.3 invited all delegates to clarify their position on this issue in order to take a final decision at the November 2008 session about the discontinuation of this agenda item.
- 4/ AC.3 requested GRSG to consider the possibility to develop such gtr taking into account cost/benefit analysis, in order to enable AC.3 to take a decision on this proposal at the June 2008 session.
- 5/ No activity at the present time by the informal group on gtr No. 5, awaiting the adoption of the ISO standard regarding Ethernet based wired communication.
