## A. PROPOSAL

Annex 7

Paragraph 1.1.5, amend to read:

"1.1.5 Any special treatment which one **or more** of the layers of glass may have undergone."

## B. JUSTIFICATION

When a glass is specially treated, its mechanical strength increases. In the case of a laminated-glass windscreen one or more layers of glass can have special treatment.

Therefore, there is no reason why laminated glass, other than windscreen, can not have special treatment on more than one layer of glass.

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
