# Other amendment proposals

#### 1.2.1 Definitions

# Transmitted by the Government of Austria 1,2

1. The terms "watertight" and "weathertight" are used in the rules for construction of Part 9 especially in the regulations for stability. In the Rhine area the terms are defined in the Rhine Inspection Rules and in the European Union they are defined by congruent definitions of Directive 2006/87/EC. But for the area of applicability of the ADN there are no harmonized and binding definitions.

2. To ensure a harmonized interpretation of the rules for construction it is proposed to add the following definitions of the Rhine Inspection Rules and Directive 2006/87/EC to the definitions in 1.2.1 of the regulations annexed to ADN:

"Watertight means a structural component or device so fitted as to prevent any ingress of water;

Weathertight means a structural component or device so fitted that in normal conditions it allows only a negligible quantity of water to penetrate;"
