# Proposal for Corrigendum 2 to the 06 series of amendments to Regulation No. 16 (Safety-belts)

#### Submitted by the Working Party on Passive Safety \*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Passive Safety (GRSP) at its forty-seventh session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/2010/10, not amended (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/47, para. 22). It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration.

<sup>\*</sup> In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2006–2010 (ECE/TRANS/166/Add.1, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 8.1.1., amend to read:

"8.1.1. With the exception of seating intended solely for use when the vehicle is stationary, the seats of vehicles of categories  $M_1$ ,  $M_2$  (of Class III or B  $\underline{9}$ /),  $M_3$  (of Class III or B  $\underline{9}$ /) and N shall be equipped with safety-belts or restraint systems which satisfy the requirements of this Regulation.

Contracting Parties applying this Regulation may demand the installation of safety belts on M<sub>2</sub> and M<sub>3</sub> vehicles belonging to Class II.

When fitted, the safety belts and/or restraint systems in Class I, II or A vehicles belonging to category  $M_2$  or  $M_3$  have to be in compliance with the requirements of this Regulation.

Contracting Parties may, under national law, allow the installation of safety belts or restraint systems other than those covered by this Regulation provided that they are intended for disabled people.

Restraint systems complying with the provisions of Annex 8 of the 02 series of amendments to Regulation No. 107 are exempted from the provisions of this Regulation.

Class I, or A vehicles belonging to category  $M_2$  or  $M_3$  may be fitted with safety belts and/or restraint systems conforming to the requirements of this Regulation."
