Consideration of draft amendments to existing Regulations

Proposal for Supplement 13 to Regulation No. 43 (Safety glazing)

Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions */

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety (GRSG) at its ninety-seventh session in order to exclude L vehicles without bodywork from the scope of Regulation No. 43. It is based on informal document GRSG-97-10 as reproduced in the report (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/76, para. 26). It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration.

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

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"1. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to:

- (a) safety glazing materials intended for installation as windscreens or other panes, or as partitioning, on vehicles of category L with bodywork, M, N, O, and T $\frac{1}{2}$;
- (b) vehicles of category M, N and O with regard to the installation of these materials;

in both cases, to the exclusion of glazing for lighting and light-signalling devices and instrument panels, of special bullet-proof glazing and of double-windows.
