




25-30 DAY:TRAVEL TIME


45-60 DAY:TIME TRAVEL

Corridor arrangements




Islamabad-Tehran-Istanbul Container and Passenger Trains

> -Demonstration run in 2009 -Time graph and tariffs have been finalized


Almaty-Istanbul Container and Passenger Trains
