Carriage of used lithium batteries contained in equipment assigned to UN Nos. 3091 and 3481

Revised proposal Transmitted by the Government of Belgium and Germany

Belgium and Germany suggest amending the first sentence of special provision 636 (b) to read as follows (new text is underlined):

"Used lithium cells and batteries with a gross mass of not more than 500 g each, wether<u>or</u> not contained in equipement, collected and presented for carriage for disposal between the eonsumer collecting point and the <u>or in the case of lithium batteries contained in equipment</u> also between the consumer and the intermediate processing facility, together or not with other non-lithium cells or batteries, are <u>up to the intermediate processing facility</u> not subject to the other provisions of RID/ADR if they meet the following conditions: ...".
