Proposals for amendments to Annexes A and B of ADR: miscellaneous proposals

Amendment to the definition "ADR approval" in section 9.1.1.2

Transmitted by the Government of Romania

- 1. Section 9.1.2 refers to the approval of EX/II, EX/III, FL, OX and AT vehicles and MEMUs.
- 2. Sub-section 9.1.2.1 General stipulates: "EX/II, EX/III, FL, OX and AT vehicles and MEMUs shall comply with the relevant requirements of this Part."

Nevertheless, in sub-section 9.1.1.2 Definitions, "ADR approval" is defined as follows:

- 3. ""ADR approval" means certification by a competent authority of a Contracting Party that a single vehicle intended for the carriage of dangerous goods satisfies the relevant technical requirements of this Part as an EX/II, EX/III, FL, OX, or AT vehicle."
- 4. In order to harmonise the prescriptions in section 9.1.2 and sub-section 9.1.2.1 with the definition "ADR approval" in 9.1.1.2, it is necessary to amend this definition to include MEMUs.

Proposal

5. Add the words "or MEMU" at the end of the definition "ADR approval" and delete "or" before "AT".
