SCOPE AND PURPOSE

- 1. Under the auspices of the Working Party on Inland Water Transport (SC.3) of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), the UNECE secretariat is organizing on 16 June 2011 an expert meeting on strategic development of inland waterway infrastructure in Europe. The meeting will be held during the thirty-ninth session of the UNECE Working Party on the Standardization of Technical and Safety Requirements in Inland Navigation (SC.3/WP.3) (15-17 June 2011).
- 2. The goal of the meeting is to discuss the next steps on the further development of inland water transport (IWT) infrastructure in the UNECE region and elaborate proposals on joint actions by the institutions involved in the IWT promotion and development. The results of the meeting shall be disseminated to the relevant international institutions and submitted to the fifty-fifth session of SC.3 (12-14 October 2011).
- 3. The target audience is the representatives of UNECE member States, river navigation commissions, waterway operators and administrations, inland navigation promotion and development organizations, inland navigation educational institutions and experienced consultants and research institutes.
