## Proposal for Supplement 1 to the 03 series of amendments to Regulation No. 95 (Lateral collision protection)

## **Submitted by the Working Party on Passive Safety \***

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Passive Safety (GRSP) at its forty-ninth session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/2011/2, as amended by Annex VIII to the report (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/49, para. 35). It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration.

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 2.20., amend to read:

"2.20. "Exposed conductive part" means the conductive part which can be touched under the provisions of the protection IPXXB and which becomes electrically energized under isolation failure conditions. This includes parts under a cover that can be removed without using tools."
