Proposal for Supplement 15 to Regulation No. 50 (Position, stop, direction indicator lamps for mopeds and motorcycles)

Submitted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling $(GRE)^*$

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its sixty-fourth session. It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2009/68, as amended by Annex XIII to the report. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/64, para. 40).

^{*} In accordance with the programme of work of the Inland Transport Committee for 2006–2010 (ECE/TRANS/166/Add.1, programme activity 02.4), the World Forum will develop, harmonize and update Regulations in order to enhance the performance of vehicles. The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.

Paragraph 3.1.2., amend to read:

"3.1.2. In the case of a front position lamp an indication whether it is intended to emit white or amber light."

Paragraph 9., amend to read:

"9. COLOUR OF LIGHT EMITTED

Stop lamps and rear position lamps shall emit red light, front position lamps may emit white or amber light, direction indicators shall emit amber light. ..."
